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JANUARY ADVISING ACCESS CHECK

Access to academic advising is a shared responsibility.

Between January 12th and 30th, 25 late cancellations and 26 missed appointments resulted in **25.5 hours of lost advising time**—the equivalent of over **3 full business days of advising** that could not be reallocated to other students.

With **only 5 advisors serving over 2,300 PSY majors**, every appointment slot matters! Missing appointments and canceling with less than 30 hours' notice reduce access for other students who are trying to meet with an advisor.

To increase transparency and promote mindful scheduling, we will continue sharing monthly data on no-shows and late cancellations throughout this semester.

Cancelling early and booking intentionally make a measurable difference!


