GRADUATE COURSES TAUGHT:

Quantitative Research Design & Analysis (PSY 815, Michigan State University)

Statistical analysis of data from experimental and nonexperimental research. Analysis of Variance techniques: single factor designs, post-hoc tests, Type I and II errors and power, multiple factor designs, breaking down interaction effects, nested designs, repeated measures designs, and mixed designs. Multiple Regression techniques: measures of bivariate association, multiple predictor variables, interactions with continuous predictor variables, categorical predictor variables, and Analysis of Covariance.

Research Methods in Social Psychology (PSY 835, Michigan State University)

Seminar designed to introduce graduate students to new methodological and data analytic models in social psychology. Topics covered include experimental design, validity, mediation and moderation, models of group research including the social relations model, diary methods, models of dyadic interaction, reliability theory, psychophysiological measures in social research, and quasi-experimental design.

Social and Personality Psychology (Psy 824, Michigan State University)

This course is designed to expose graduate students to a number of classic and contemporary theories and controversies that guide social psychological research. The topics covered in this course represent a selection of major themes in the field and each topic will provide students with the opportunity to develop their understanding of the field as well as learn how social psychologists think about and conduct research.
