Preschool Trauma and Loss Project

This is a 2 semester course. First semester—learn research, theories, and intervention techniques. Second semester—co-lead a 16-lesson program to help preschoolers living in poverty cope with trauma and loss.

What Students Will Learn

- Trauma and stress associated with poverty and racism
- The effects of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)
- Theories and research about trauma and resilience
- Interventions to help preschoolers cope with traumatic events
- How to conduct a classroom behavioral assessment
- Interviewing skills
- Writing initial and final reports integrating parent and teacher interviews and behavioral assessments

Class meets Mondays, 12:40-3:20pm both semesters.
