#### **PSY Human Service Internship Program**– Apply now!

Seats are still available for the Human Service Internship for Spring/ Summer 2021! This program is designed for the student planning for a career working directly with people in need. It teaches students how to effectively help people in direct-service situations, whether through nonprofit organizations (e.g., homeless shelters, domestic abuse programs, refugee services, foster care services) or government jobs (e.g., child protective services, foster care). The class uses lectures, discussions, guest speakers, videos, homework, in-class assignments, and tests to enhance your understanding of the material. This course is a two-semester commitment, (Spring/Summer) and students must agree to sign up for both semesters in order to be allowed into the course. # Virtual CAPS Connect

<u>CAPS Connect</u> is a consultation-based service for MSU students in which specific CAPS staff are assigned to unique student populations/ areas of campus.
